Dr Robert Bolt is Director of the University of Sheffield's "One-to-One" dental implantology course, and is Implantology Lead for The University of Sheffield's undergraduate curriculum. He is both medically and dentally qualified, and completed a period of extended training in Oral Surgery, which included complex surgery relating to dental implantology. Dr Bolt's clinical interests include dental implantology, guided bone regeneration, sinus surgery and the use of extensive grafting techniques in the management of bony defects. Dr. Bolt also has interests in dental sedation and video capture of surgery for means of student teaching.
